## Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyaan

### 1. Introduction

Swachh Bharat: Swachh Vidyalaya is the national campaign driving 'Clean India: Clean Schools'. The campaign supports India's Right to Education Act (2009). A key feature of the campaign is to ensure that every school in India has a set of functioning and well maintained water, sanitation and hygiene facilities. Water, sanitation and hygiene in schools improve children's health, school enrolment, attendance and retention and paves the way for new generation of healthy children. It is the role of policymakers, government representatives, citizens and parents to make sure that every child attends a school that has access to safe drinking water, proper sanitation and hygiene facilities. This is every child's right.

SECL being pioneer in its community engagements taken a lead in "Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan" by planning to Construct/Repair of toilets in Schools across various states. This programme was launched on 02.10.2014 across Chhattisgarh & Madhya Pradesh states by various operating areas of SECL. The targets fixed for SECL are 12569 Toilets across Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha.

50% of the SECL CSR fund of FY 2014-15 is earmarked for Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan.

### 2. Target Assigned-

Under Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan, SECL has been allotted the targets for construction/repairing of toilets by Coal India Limited under the CSR head. The targets fixed for SECL are in the states of Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha as given below-

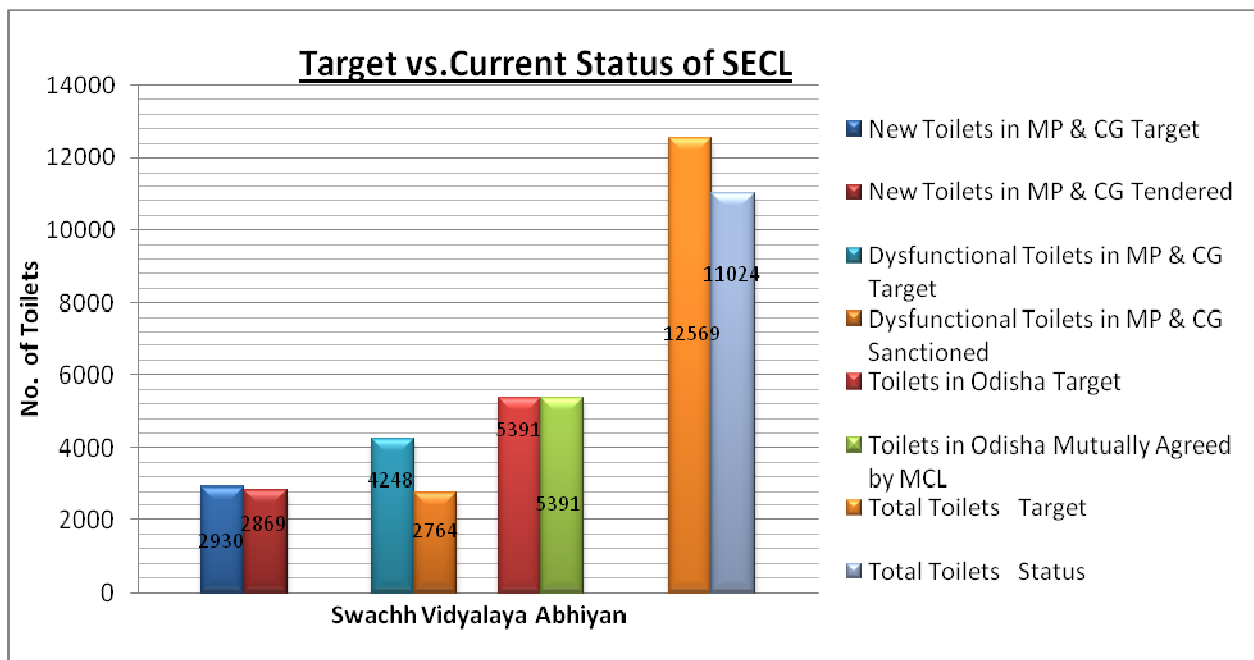
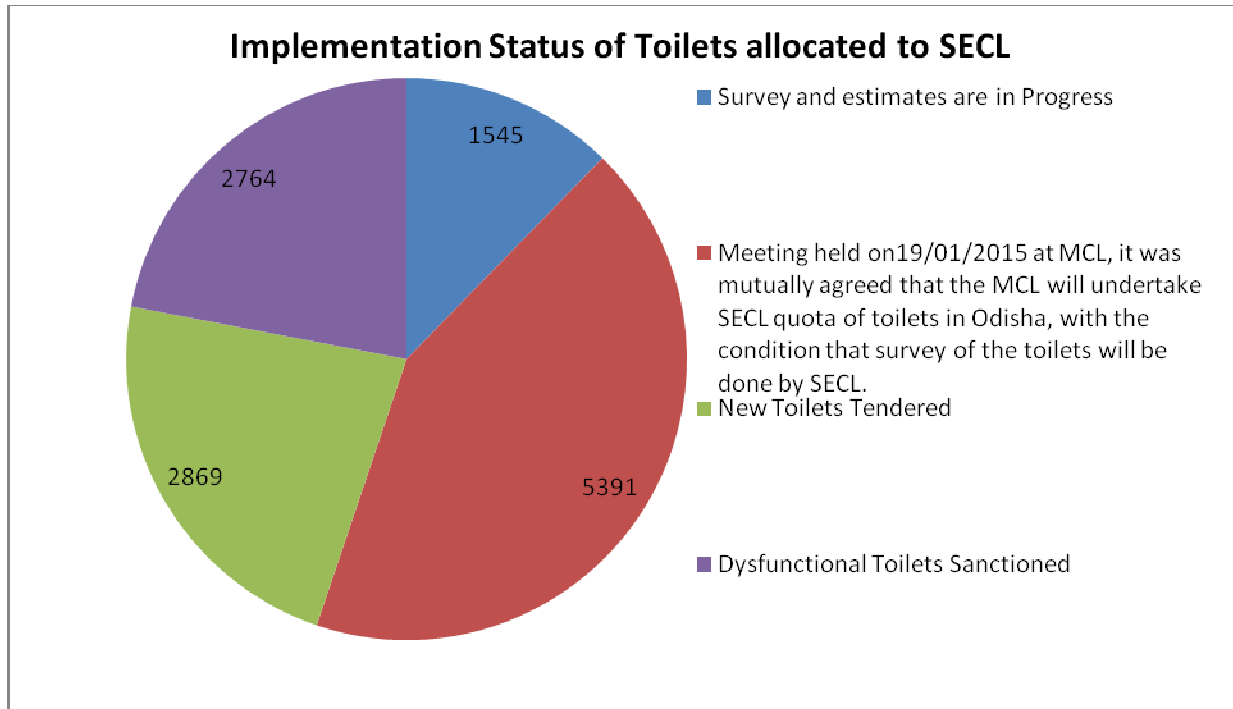

With respect of CG and MP states, the no. of schools in which toilets are to be constructed/repaired allotted to SECL is 4598 covering 7178 toilets.
